My current interests interrogate how art can expand the notion of private and public identities mainly through the affect of sound in various spaces (physical, cultural and the body). I am also continuously exploring the spectrum between perception of patterns and abstraction through use of sound.

I am a co-founder and artistic director of England registered charity <u>Liquid Listening</u> which pioneered Musical Hydrotherapy practice in Special Needs schools and institutions in the UK. Musical Hydrotherapy is the practice of supporting people for sub-surface listening at hydrotherapy pools.
